



## Submission guidelines poster presentation

- Submission are made via **ConfTool** (<https://www.conftool.pro/eaee2023>). The ConfTool submission system for poster presentations will be open from December 1<sup>st</sup> 2022 until April 1<sup>st</sup> 2023. You will be required to (1) upload your poster presentation proposal as a pdf and (2) provide additional information directly in the online submission system as indicated below.
- Guidelines for the creation of your **poster presentation proposal**:
  - The poster presentation proposal needs to be submitted as a **structured long abstract**. The proposal should not have a separate title page (first page) but rather present the following items in consecutive order taking the indicated word limits into account.
  - Start with the **title** of your contribution using Title Case (i.e., starting each word with a capital letter and continue in lower case).
  - A short **abstract** (max. 150 words) that gives a clear idea of the main conclusions of the poster, the methods employed and some indication of the line of reasoning.
  - A maximum of five **keywords**, separated by commas.
  - A **problem statement** (max. 100 words) detailing what issue(s) the poster is investigating.
  - **Research question(s) and objectives** (max. 100 words) that explain what the research is trying to achieve and which contribution(s) are made to the existing literature.
  - **Methods** (max. 300 words): brief outline of the methodology.
  - **Data** (max. 200 words): brief description of the data used in the research, if applicable.
  - **Results** (max. 400 words): outline of main results and conclusions
  - Collect **References** at the end of the proposal. For referencing please refer to the style of the [European Review of Agricultural Economics](#).
  - Please refrain from adding any extra sections or appendices and do not use footnotes.
  - Tables and figures, if applicable, should be placed in the text near to their citation. Number tables and figures consecutively. Type captions with an initial capital only.
  - Please use a serif font type such as “Times New Roman”, font size 12, line spacing “1.5 lines”, and normal margins (2.5 cm all sides).
- **Necessary additional information** to complete the online submission:
  - Title of the contributed poster presentation
  - Author(s): name, ORCID, affiliation, contact details
  - Abstract (max. 150 words): should be repeated verbatim from your proposal
  - Keywords (max. 5): should be repeated verbatim from your proposal
  - You will need to select a specific stream and max. 4 topics that best suit your poster presentation from a predefined list
  - Indicate whether your final poster can be uploaded to the AgEcon Search repository
