

Guided walking tour of the Rennes city center



Embark on a guided sightseeing tour of the Rennes city center and discover the city history and heritage. Discover the winding streets lined with colorful half-timbered houses and a décor inspired from Roman basilicas. Pass through the Portes Mordelaises – old city gates and an excellent example of defensive medieval heritage. Walk the cobbled pedestrian area between the City Hall and the Opera House. Contemplate the architecture of the Parliament of Brittany – a court of justice built under King Louis XIV and reconstructed after the great fire of 1720 by the chief architect of King Louis XV – and the neighboring private mansions of “Parliament men”. As you stroll through the city, the touristic guide will talk you through the history and meaning of each monument and stop.

Duration of the visit: 1 hour 30 minutes

Starting point: Le Couvent des Jacobins (the congress venue)
